

Parting-Action of moving something, (विदाई), Pass-Mr. Parker+Ring, Story-Mr. Parker ring bajatge-bajate (बजाते-बजाते) apni (अपनी) beti (बेटी) ki bidai (विदाई) kar rahe hai. (adj,n) (Ref. page no.167 rule no. 41)



Partisan (पाटीसन)— Supporter of a person or party, (किसी दल का समर्थक), Pass- Mr. Parker+Tea (चाय)+Sun, Story- Mr. Parker tea (चाय) aur sun wali party ke samarthak (समर्थक) hai. (Ref. page no. 166-167 rule no. 3 & 38)



Partridge (पारिट्रज) — Short game bird, (तितर), Pass—Mr. Parker+Tree+Edge (कोने), Story—Mr. Parker tree ke edges (कोने) par (पर) titar (तितर) ko rakh (रख) rahe hai. (n)




Pat (पैट)—At the right moment, Small lump of something, (सही वक्त पर), (थपथपाना), (टिकिया), Pass- Payal+Tea (चाय), Story- Payal mehmano (मेहमानो) ke liye...

Patch (पैच)— Piece of material used to cover torn, (चिप्पी), (पैबंद), Pass-Payal+Tea+Chacha, Story—Payal aur chacha tea pee (पी) rahe the tabhi (तभी) chacha ke kahne (कहने) par payal chippi (चिप्पी) lagane (लगाने) lagti (लगती) hai. (n) (Ref. page no. 166 rule no. 3)



Pate (पेट)— Person's head, (सिर), Pass-Payal+Tea (चाय)+E-girl, Story-Payal E-girl ke sir (सिर) par Tea (चाय) rakh (रख) rahi hai. (n) (Ref. page no. 166 rule no. 3)



Pathetic (पथैटिक)— Miserable, Arousing pity, (दयनीय), Pass—Payal+Thoda (थोड़ा)+Tic-tic (टिक-टिक) (watch), Story—Payal thode (थोड़े) dukhi (दुःखी) logo (लोगो) ko tic-tic (टिक-टिक) (watch) de rahi hai. (adj) (Ref. page no. 166 rule no. 17 & 18)



Pathos (पेथोस)— Situation that evokes pity or sadness, (करूणा रस), Pass- Payal+Dhos (धाँस), Story- Payal karuna ras (करूणा रस) mein gaana (गाना) gaa (गा) rahi hai aur ek aunty use (उसे) dhos धाँस) dikha (दिखा) rahi hai. (n)



Patriarch (पेट्रीआर्क)— Head of a family, (परिवार का मुखिया), Pass-Payal+Tree+Arch, Story-Payal apne pariwar ke mukhiya (परिवार के मुखिया) ke sath (साथ) tree par baith (बैट) kar arch bana rahi hai. (n)



Patricide (पैट्रीसाइड)— killer of one's own father, (अपने पिता का हत्यारा), Pass— Payal+Tree+Side, Story— Payal tree ke side mein apne pita ki hatya (अपने पिता की हत्या) kar rahi hai. (n)



Patrimony (पेट्रमोनी)— Inherited property from one's own father, (पेतृक सम्पत्ति), Pass- Payal+Tree+Money, Story-Payal tree ke side se...


Paucity (पौसिटी)- Scarecity, (कमी), Pass- Pao (पाव)+City, Story-City mein jaha pao (पाव) rakha (रखा) hai waha har cheez (चीज) ki kami (कमी) hai. (n)



Paunch (पौन्य)- Belly, (तांद), Pass- Pao (पाव)+Chacha, Story- Chacha pao (पाव) khate (खाते) hai jiske (जिसके) karan (कारण) unki tondh (तोंद) nikal jati hai. (n)



(पाव)+Par (पर), Story- Ek atyadhik gareeb (अत्यधिक गरीब) ladka (लड़का) pao (पाव) par baith (बैठ) kar bheekh (भिख) mang (मांग) raha hai. (n)



Pave (पेव) Make a road, (रास्ता बनाना), Pass Payal+Miss. Vee, Story-Payal aur Miss. Vee, V ki madad (मदद) se road bana (बना) rahi hai. (v)
